**NCSFA** — Tim Bradley reported. Tim introduced NCSFA members, present and past, that were in attendance. He gave an update on the scholarship program. Conference is coming up in Charlotte August 10-12. He gave a brief list of items that will take place during Conference. The NCSFA will be mailing out changes to Bylaws that will be voted on at Conference. He highlighted items that have been proposed for changing, mostly just minor items. Some legislature issues coming up. This is a short session so no new items can be brought up this year. The PNCFA meet with the NCSFA and voted to support the changes to the Bylaws.
